

Picking up the Equipment

- 1) Home team of the first game has pick up and set up –
- 2) Once you have arrived at the home of the net location – please do not knock on the door. The equipment is typically out with the exception of 5918 Chevell Court. The nets, flags and if needed, ladders are stored inside the shed to the left (as you are facing the house) of the house. At the home of 5918 Chevell Court everything is labeled. Make sure you take the correct equipment.

Setting up the Field

- 1) When you get to the field – unlock the goal. If a key is used, return the key to the duffle bag.

!!! Make sure all children and supervised at all times around unsecured goals while setup/takedown are taking place!!!

- 2) If a combo is used – you MUST read the following:

Treat this lock as if it were your own. It is an expensive lock– Be gentle with it. When you are relocking the lock - you MUST “realign” the numbers. Do not FORCE the lock to open or to closed. If the combo is correct – it should lock and unlock smoothly.

- 3) Relock the chain to prevent being lost.
- 4) Flip the goals so they look like “SLEDS” and slide them over to be positioned. Do not drag them any other way - it causes the bolts to loosen
- 5) Flip the goals so the cross bar is off the ground and at “THIGH” level.
- 6) Attach the net onto the cross bar before standing up the goals up right - this way you won't need a ladder... plus it's easier on your back- start at one end - (there will be a seam in the net - that is the corner. Start to velcro at that end - stretching the net while velcroing the net to the other end.
- 7) Place the "Black bag" filled with sand OVER the back of the goal's side base on both the left and right side of the goal
- 8) Stake the back of the nets down & finish velcroing the side of the nets to the goal posts
- 9) Place corner post flags on field

Field Take Down

Look at the NET BAG to see how to replace and store Sand bags and portable goals.
DO NOT DEVIATE!

Treat this lock as if it were your own. It is an expensive lock– Be gentle with it. When you are relocking the lock - you MUST “realign” the numbers.
Do not FORCE the lock to open or to closed. If the combo is correct – it should lock and unlock smoothly.

- 1) Collect the Corner Flags. If there is a flag bag – place two of the spikes at one end of the bag. Place the other two spikes at the other end of the flag bag. This will prevent the bag from being bottom heavy, which will prevent punctures through the flag bags.
- 2) Collect the stakes and replace them in the small spike bag. They should NOT be thrown into the net bag. This will prevent hand puncture wounds for the next team who has set up duties.
- 3) After everything has been packed up please READ the net tag and follow instructions.
- 4) Be sure to return nets/flags **within one hour** of end of game (do not take home or out to dinner first)
- 5) Once you have arrived at the location for the net drop off – please do not knock on the door. :) Thank you!!
- 6) Re-read the instructions. Please replace equipment back as indicated on the net tag. Everything is labeled inside the shed at 5918 Chevell Court.
- 7) If there are pieces of equipment missing please e-mail LMVSClub@aol.com so they can be replace – i.e. Mallet – stakes – Velcro etc.
